## Press release - November 2, 2024



Regarding the misleading, factious and untrue statements, exposed by suspended member Mr. Giuseppe Mario D'Agostino.

AIAD, in order to safeguard its image and within the scope of our mandate, always in the protection and defence of race, states the following:

despite announcing his resignation on social media channels, the member in question neglected to mention important aspects of his time as a club member.

- 1. He has a definitive suspension for months 23 imposed by the Commissions of I and II instances of the Enci for false certifications of cut ears and tails.
- 2. In a criminal trial where he was the only defendant for the same facts, where AIAD and 4 other animal protection associations have taken legal action, there was a judgment of 'not to proceed' for extinguishment due to the crime prescription at the beginning of the time, he preferred not to submit himself to the Judge's judgment, fearing the conviction for the facts established in the trial.
- 3. During the same process we were informed that he filed a birth complaint for litter with Model A. According to his signature, 16 puppies were born, a few days before the standard change exactly on 29/07/2016, declaration presented by Mr. D'Agostino at the local offices Enci, when the puppies were already 24 days old. The trial minutes shows the declaration under oath of the keeper of the female and litter: the live puppies, born in his house were only 7, as then stated in Model B and not 16.
- 4. He neglected to mention that he has been relocating his breeding and interests to Serbia for a while now. He stated that he now resides in the country, where he produces dobermann with pedigrees issued by the Serbian Kennel Club. His breeding is no longer registered in Italy.
- 5. He neglected to mention that he was identified by the Gorizia Police along with two Serbian people, while he was at dawn in the parking of the service area of Duino Nord, near the border, 1450 km from his home, near a car with inside 9 Dobermann puppies with tail and ears dokked, then seized and taken in Trentino.
- 6. He neglected to mention that he mysteriously lost a Beauceron champion who was entrusted to him by the owner for a fee to show it at a local Expo on a small island of the Maltese archipelago. The dog disappeared, but there has been no news.
- 7. Finally, the AIAD section in Catania, managed exclusively by him, in his interest. From official data verified in the secretariat, we did not have the members declared by him. Thus onother false fact.

We have official documents that prove all of the above.
